Things to consider when preparing to conduct a piece.

- 1. How is the text grouped? In 2, 3 or 4 or a combination.
 - a. Just because a piece has a meter signature does not always mean you will conduct that pattern for the entire piece.
- 2. Are there marking for phrasing and dynamics?
 - a. Markings for crescendo, diminuendo, dynamics, as well as the word stress or inflection of the text will guide you in determining the size of the beat.

Conducting terms that will be used. (Bev Henson technique)

Finger tips, wrist, half arm, whole arm, low plane, mid plane, high plane
